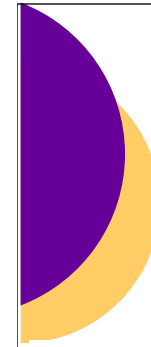

Supervised & Supportive Visitation

Provides the child(ren) of divided families with access to their non-custodial parent in a neutral, safe, supportive and homelike environment.

Therapeutic Visitation

Provides parent(s) and child(ren) with the completion of therapeutic goals that can include healing of past trauma, communication of feelings, and provide the parent(s) with a better understanding of the needs of the child(ren).

Custody Exchanges

Exchanges are made at pre-arranged times that are staggered so parents will not have contact with one another.

How to get started:

1. Each party must call to schedule an intake appointment. These intakes must be in person and be completed before visitations can begin.
2. Parties must bring a photo ID and a copy of the court order (if applicable) to the intake.
3. After the intake, the Children's Center will contact both parties to arrange a scheduled day(s) and time for visitations and exchanges to occur.
4. Payment (if applicable) is due at the time of service. We do offer a sliding fee scale.
5. Children's Center rules must be followed at all times to ensure the safety of all those involved.
